

In 722 B.C. the Assyrian army successfully breached the walls of Israel's capital, Samaria. The city was destroyed and the people were carried into exile. This tragedy happened because of their rebellion against God. God's Story is replete with examples of people who brought judgment on themselves due to sin.

Sometimes, however, His displeasure is expressed as grief over the waywardness of His people.

When "God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth ... it grieved him at his heart" in the time of Noah (Gen. 6:5-6).

But God's Story also has many examples of people who repented and turned back to God, experiencing His acceptance and rich blessing as a result.

*Most of the Bible examples we study of God's judgment involve large numbers of people.*

*Do you believe God meets you on a personal level?*

*Then you should believe His judgment has the same personal attributes.*
