

Stand Down ~ Solve Conflict

All relationships struggle at some point, but whether they survive or divide depends largely on our ability to forgive. We've burned some relationship bridges in our lifetime. Bridges — plural. Some relationships may indeed be so toxic they must be severed. But, sometimes, those burned bridges are symbols of unforgiveness. Most of us have a few ruptured relationships we've left behind.

Six Conciliation Responses (How to Respond)

1. Overlook an Offense — Proverbs 19:11
2. Discussion — Matthew 5:23-24
3. Negotiation — Philippians 2:4
4. Mediation — Matthew 18:16
5. Arbitration — 1 Corinthians 6:4
6. Accountability — Matthew 18:17

Three Escape Responses (How Not to Respond)

1. Denial — Pretending problems don't exist or refusing to do what should be done to resolve a conflict properly is seldom helpful.
2. Flight — Running away by ending a friendship, quitting a job, filing for divorce, or changing churches. Flight is legitimate only in extreme circumstances.
3. Suicide — Taking one's life because all hope is lost. Suicide is never a right way to deal with conflict.

Three Attack Responses (How Not to Respond)

1. Assault — Using physical force, intimidation, or verbal attacks to overcome an opponent.
2. Litigation — Taking an opponent to court. Since lawsuits usually damage relationships and often fail to achieve complete justice.
3. Murder — Killing opponents to win a dispute.
