

Never Compromise Biblical Right or Wrong

We must never compromise when it is a matter of biblical right or wrong. So are you willing to "stick your neck out" for issues that are a matter of biblical right or wrong? Consider areas of your life where you need to confront conflict.

*** It could be in a friendship, your family, or a work situation.

*** It may be in the church where you know an issue of biblical truth is being compromised.

*** It could be where the gospel of grace is being shunned for a practice of legalism.

You may be the one God uses to confront the conflict and steer people back to truth. Make sure your purpose is pure and grounded in love, but don't be afraid to stand for truth and be an agent of change. That is what faithful followers of Christ do.

The goal of any confrontation is to be redemptive. If truth is being compromised or ignored, we should do what is necessary to correct the situation. We should do this in a way that doesn't simply condemn the other person's actions, but instead, leads him or her back to the truth and a closer walk with Jesus Christ.

How should I stand my ground?

*** Pray, pray, pray, asking God to give you insight into the situation-then depend on the Holy Spirit's guidance (John 14:26).

*** Be clear about "the truth of the gospel" for which you are standing your ground (Gal. 2:14).

*** Stand your ground, but present the truth in love (Eph. 4:15).
