These and many others miss the greater point.

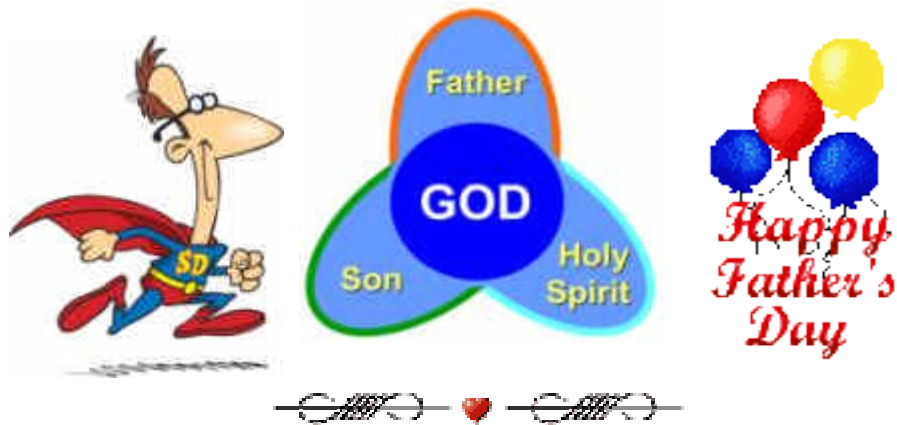
The Lord is not looking for perfection in the Law or Morality.
