IN LOVE'S CIRCLE

Teaching the Song

Introduction: *(Hold up a gold circle.)* What does a circle remind you of? *(Let the children respond.)* This circle has no beginning or end. It reminds me of God and His love because His love never ends.

Presentation: *(Sing the song for the children while showing the visual.)*

Explanation: *Chorus:* God's love has no end. It just keeps going on and on. God will never stop loving you and He wants you to love others too. When you show God's love to others, you are part of God's love circle that goes on forever. You can tell those who are bound—tied up by sin—that God loves them and Jesus died to pay for their sins.

Verse 1: Real love comes only from God. It's not from us because every good and perfect thing comes from God. God's perfect love circle joins all who believe in Him together as one family.

Verse 2: When we come together like we do in *Good News Club*[®] (or other ministry), we learn more about God and we agree with what He says in His Word, the Bible. Jesus, our Savior, is always with us and He shows us how to love other people.

Application: *Unsaved:* If you have never trusted Jesus as your Savior, He wants you to be in the circle of His loving family. You can believe in Him today! *(Give an invitation to receive Christ now or at another time in the class hour.)*

Saved: If you have already asked Jesus to be your Savior, you are in the circle of His loving family. Now you can show His love to others around you. You can be kind to them and best of all, you can tell them how to trust Jesus as Savior and have their sin forgiven.

Repetition: *(Have the children stand in a circle and sing the song with you once. Then sing it again while the children join hands and walk around the circle clockwise. Repeat and walk counter-clockwise.)*
